

## Grace~ism Pt. 2 - One Source

### #1 - THE ISSUE

The biggest issue with relativistic morality:

#1 - It categorically denies any absolute \_\_\_\_\_, especially \_\_\_\_\_.

**Moral Relativism:** *The view that ethical standards, morality, and the positions of right and wrong are culturally based and therefore subject to a persons individual choices. That we can all decide for ourselves what is right and wrong.*

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### #2 - THE LIE

A - **Genesis 3:1-6** *<sup>1</sup>Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "**Did God really say,** 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"* \_\_\_\_\_

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B - This Lie the enemy wants you to believe is that you cannot take God at His word.

**1 Peter 3:15-16** *<sup>15</sup>But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. \_\_\_\_\_ t o everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, <sup>16</sup>keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.<sup>(NIV)</sup>*

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### #3 - THE ANSWER

In Matthew 4 we read about Jesus being tempted in the dessert for 40 days by the devil who gives Him *three tests*... How does jesus defend Himself???

The word of God: Three times jesus is tempted, and three times He responds with \_\_\_\_\_

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### #4 - THE METHOD

A - \_\_\_\_\_ Apologetics

Which means that we come to every conversation fully convinced that the Bible has the \_\_\_\_\_, a n d best, answer.

What we do is try to have a directed conversation... this is called **socratic evangelism... or in the method of Socrates...** What you are trying to do in this is pull the truth out of them.

B - The “\_\_\_\_\_ answer, \_\_\_\_\_ strategy”

It comes from **Proverbs 26:4-5** <sup>4</sup>*Do not answer a fool according to his folly, or you yourself will be just like him.* <sup>5</sup>*Answer a fool according to his folly, or he will be wise in his own eyes*<sup>(NIV)</sup>.

First: We do not answer the fool according to their folly...

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Second: answer the fool according to their folly- *this is where you need to spend time developing your ability to work a conversation.*

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
