B - Theos:

John 1:1 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God (Theos), and the Word was God (Theos). 2 He was in the beginning with God (Theos). 3 All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.(NASB) _____

- Titus 2:11-13 11 For the grace of God (Theos) has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, 12 instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, 13 looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God (Theos) and Savior, Christ Jesus... (NASB)

- Isaiah 9:6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.(NASB)

C - Kyrios:

- Used 6814 times in the Greek Old Testament.

- Mark 1:2-3 2 As it is written in Isaiah the prophet: "behold, I send My messenger ahead of You, who will prepare Your way; 3 The voice of one crying in the wilderness, 'Make ready the way of the Lord (Kyrios), make His paths straight.'(NASB)

- 1 Corinthians 8:6 yet for us there is but one God (Theos), the Father, from whom are all things and we exist for Him; and one Lord (Kyrios), Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we exist through Him. (NASB)

- Luke 2:10-11 10 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy which will be for all the people 11 for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord (Kyrios).(NASB)

- Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord (Kyrios), and believe in your heart that God (Theos) raised Him from the dead, you will be saved...(NASB)
