2 - "How Will They Know"

Romans 10:14-17

A - Pauls direct concern is the lack of missionaries to the Jews, but the universal message here is very clear. Transformative, life changing, faith only comes by hearing and believing the truth about Christ... nothing else.

Learning about the word of God: 2 Timothy 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who doesn't need to be ashamed, correctly teaching the word of truth. (HCSB)
