B -An unfortunate and all too common unbiblical argument:

One of the more difficult topics for modern day Christians to wrestle with is the need for, and importance of proper Theological & Doctrinal understanding. _____

We hear "God accepts you just the way you are", which He does...

They teach all Grace without repentance, and forgiveness without the need for change...

They teach "Doing Good" but never "Knowing God"

Some of the arguments you will here sound like this:

"The Bible is not about being right or wrong, its about loving Jesus"

"I don't need to learn from a man because I have the Holy Spirit"

"I know what the Bible says, but I have prayed and I have a peace about ... fill in the blank"

How many of us here have heard these types of arguments?

- These kind of arguments may sound reasonable, even spiritual, but the problem is that they are filled with half-truths, and lies.
- They prey on our rebellious nature, our offenses, and our weaknesses
- Or worse they make our rebellion look like obedience...
